## UA'S CAREER OUTCOMES RATE

Within six months, 95% of spring 2022 undergraduate degree recipients were employed full- or parttime, participating in a program of voluntary services, serving in the U.S. Armed Forces or continuing their education.



## **EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING RATE**

86%

86% of spring 2022 bachelor's degree recipients participated in at least one form of experiential learning\* before graduating.

\*Experiential learning includes internships, co-ops, practicums, assistantships, on-campus student employment, student teaching, undergraduate research, field experiences, clinicals, volunteer work related to major, and study abroad.
