 - o Learn My Akron, Springboard (online learning platform)
- Visit Zip Card Office for Student ID Card (must bring a copy of your Class Schedule)
- Veteran Students: Meet with Military Services Center to apply for VA benefits and to learn about services (330-972-7838 or <u>www.uakron.edu/veterans</u>)
