## **Academic:**

### See an Advisor to:

- Determine academic status (i.e. Probation, dismissal) and obtain Student ID#
- Determine last date of attendance
- o Complete Academic Record Reactivation form
- Discuss career objectives/majors. Do you need to visit the Career Center?
- Establish tuition/financial paths (See page two)
- Obtain UA Net ID & Password (call 330-972-6888)
- Determine if placement testing is Needed

## Financial:

- Determine previous balance (i.e. outstanding)
- o If needed, Apply for a federal PIN (Personal Identification number)
- o Complete FAFSA (fafsa.gov) Akron's Code is 003123
  - o If taxes were filed electronically then complete the FAFSA online
  - If taxes were not filed electronically still complete the application and provide the information on the next steps
  - o Review SAR report
  - Review Master Institutional Aid Application
  - You may have to go through Verification
  - Review your MY Akron for accepting and declining awards
    - Check Status of your aid
    - Review refund policy
    - Review how to keep your aid
