

ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE

- <u>Direct admission to the College</u> is given with a high-school GPA of 3.0 and ACT of 22 or SAT of 1030.
- Pre-admission students: Those who do not meet direct admission criteria are considered preadmission students. They might not be eligible to apply for certain scholarships.

MORE COMPLETE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AVAILABLE ONLINE

- · Bachelor of Arts degree (BA) or Bachelor of Arts Tagged (BAT)
- Coursework in human anatomy and physiology, physics or chemistry, psychology or sociology, and statistics are required to fulfill American Speech-Language-Hearing Association standards
- Completion of the General Education and American Speech-Language-Hearing Association requirements (48-51 credits)
- BA foreign language requirements (14 credits) or BAT requirements (13 credits)
- · Core coursework in speech-language pathology and audiology (46 credits)
- Electives (9-13 credits)
- · Observations and Clinical Techniques
- Certificate programs and minors that apply to the fields of audiology and speech-language pathology

- Accelerated program between undergraduate and graduate degree in SLP: Students can save tuition costs by completing up to 9 graduate credit hours at the undergraduate price. These same graduate credits can be applied to their graduate degree at The University of Akron.
- · Junior level students are eligible to apply
