Students wishing to apply to the Accelerated Nursing program must do so by December 1 of the third year in order to start the following May. More information is available at: uakron.edu/nursing.

Student must maintain a 2.75 GPA in all science courses to apply to the School of Nursing. Student must earn a C or higher in all science courses.
