A minimum of 120 credits are required for the Bachelor of Science degree. A student must earn a 2.0 cumulative grade point average to graduate from the Healthcare Administration program. A student is eligible to take the AAPC National Certification exam following the completion of required coursework.

Student will need to follow all requirements and application for entry to the UA School of Law: uakron.edu/law/admissions

Students admitted to the program fulfill their senior year of undergraduate credits through the successful completion of their first-year law school courses, allowing them to graduate with both a bachelor's and law degree in just six years, saving a year of tuition and related costs, and they begin their legal careers a year ahead of time.

Students admitted to University of Akron School of Law will receive BS in Healthcare Administration after completing 28 credits during the first year of Law School.
