# Beginning Dance

### **DANCE FOR CHILDREN AGES 6-8**

Our youth program is focused on refining technique, exploring repertoire, and delving into diverse dance disciplines. Dancers will focus on dance fundamentals in a supportive and enriching environment. Dancers have the option to audition for placement at age 8 for the preprofessional company or can continue in our youth dance track. Dancers at this level are eligible to audition for our ballet performances which rehearse with our repertoire class on Saturday Mornings.

Beginning Ballet: 4:30-5:15 PM Tuesdays, 5:30-6:15 PM Thursdays, 9:45-10:30 AM Saturdays

Beginning Tap/Jazz Combo: 5:15-6:00 Tuesdays, 9:00-9:45 AM Saturdays Beginning Performance Repertoire: 10:00-12:00 AM Saturdays (Performance Fee)

Each 45 minute class is \$48/month Fall August 26-December 9th



## Youth Dance

#### **DANCE FOR AGES 7+**

Our youth dance program is focused on building a strong technique, exploring repertoire, and exploring different dance disciplines. Our youth dancers will need to audition for placement and classes will align to the specific dancer's skill level. Our youth dance program allows for dancers to take just one class or a series of classes. Dancers at this level are eligible to audition for ensemble roles in our ballet performances which rehearse with our repertoire class on Saturday mornings.

Dancers at this level that wish to have a more rigorous curriculum can join our Dance Company Track.

## Dance Company

### PRE-PROFESSIONAL AGES 7+

Dancers are invited to be part of our prestigious pre-professional program. Our curriculum blends rigorous ballet classes with additional dance styles to create a well rounded dancer. Students at this level will be invited to special master classes and are eligible to compete in national competitions. Company members also receive a per class discount. This program is designed to prepare your dancer for the next step in their career or dance study. The dancer's track will be determined by their placement audition. All company members will be part of our performance series and rehearsals will be part our repertoire classes. Our Dance Company members are our ambassadors into the community.

#### Required Curriculum

Level 1: 2 (1 hour) Ballet, 1 Conditioning 1 Dance style, Repertoire \$200/month Level 2: 3 (1.5 hour) Ballet, 1 Conditioning, 2 Pointe, 1 Contemporary, Repertoire \$300/month Level 3: 4 (1.5 hour) Ballet, 3 Pointe, 1 Conditioning, 1 Contemporary, Repertoire \$400/month Level 4: 4 Ballet (1.5 hour), 3 Pointe, 1 Conditioning, 1 Contemporary, Repertoire \$400/month

Additional classes may be added to each level at a discounted rate.
