		need to find a job, work hours, and receive a paycheck in order to access the funds.
8		Total financial aid credits (line 5 + line 6 = line 8).
		Estimated balance due (line 4 – line 8 = line 9). This number is also referred to as your out-of-
		pocket contribution. A positive number means that your family will owe this amount for the
9		academic year. (The Office of Student Accounts bills per semester. Divide the amount in this box to
		determine the estimated total due per semester.) A negative number means that you will be
		eligible for a refund (once all credits are received); this can be used to manage some of your
		personal expenses.
