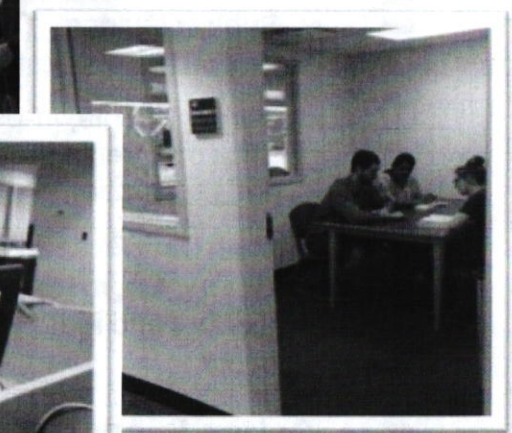
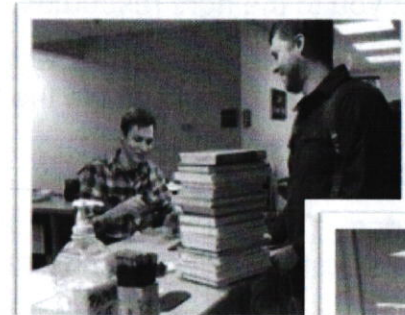
- Access unique local and regional primary resources in **Archival Services** (Polsky, Room LL10).

Print, Copy, Scan and Create!

- **The MakerStudio** (ground floor, Bierce Library) is a great place to explore and work collaboratively. You can utilize the 3D printers, HTC Vive Pro virtual reality system, drawing tablets, Cricut cutting machine, 360 cameras, Raspberry Pi, Arduino, and more!
- **Wirelessprinting** from your personal laptop (<https://support.uakron.edu>) or print from a library computer (Macs and PCs).
- Scanners, printers (b/w, color), and copiers

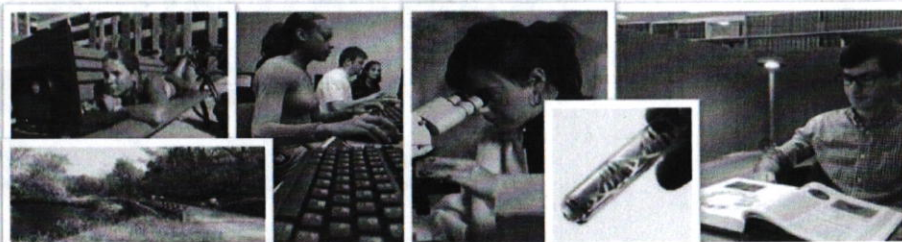
Research Support

- **Schedule a research consultation** with a professional librarian to help you at any stage of your research process, and to direct you to the right resources.

Getting Materials and Software

- **Can't find it?** Request articles via InterLibraryLoan(ILL) Services and borrow books not available at UA via OhioLINK or ILL.
- **Use your Zip card to borrow** (up to 150 books) and renew items online or by phone.
- Physical and Electronic **Course Reserves**. Physical reserves will be held at the Circulation Desk (Bierce and Science and Tech.).
- **Theses and Dissertations** (online, print)
- Access licensed software (e.g. SPSS) anytime via the **Virtual Lab**: <https://labs.uakron.edu> or in-person at the UA Libraries.

StudySupport

- **Reserve a study room online** (Bierce) or go to the 3rd floor (usually the quietest floor).
- **Most study rooms are on a first come** basis in the Science and Tech Library.
- **Equipment loans**: Laptop loans inside library, iPads loans outside library.

Lockers (Science and Tech. Library), **headphones, and whiteboards/markers** available for check out (Bierce Library and Science and Tech. Library) **DSLR** and point and shoot cameras, **video cameras**, graphing and scientific calculators that circulate to students, and a variety of standard cords (Bierce Library).
