

# What is Financial Aid?

Financial Aid is a broad group of funding sources that assists students in meeting the cost of attending college and can include grants, scholarships, work-study programs, and student loans.

# Types of Financial Aid

Gift Aid	Description
Grants	Awarded by federal and state government
Scholarships/Fellowships	Awarded by a variety of sources including the University, community groups, businesses, etc.
Self-Help Aid	Description
Student Employment/Federal Work Study	Money earned while working part-time on campus
Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans (student)	Low interest loans, repaid by the student after graduation
Private Loans	Loans that students borrow (Might often needs a cosigner), repaid after graduation







**All students** need to accept their federal direct student loans in the Student Center of MyAkron, every financial aid year.


First-time student loan borrowers need to complete two additional requirements the first time they borrow loans at UA:

- Entrance counseling
- Loan Agreement/Master Promissory Note (MPN)

Both of these can be completed online at **studentaid.gov** with the student's FSA ID (username and password)



# **Loan Considerations**



## Loan Limits (Annual and Aggregate)

Year	Dependent Undergraduates	Independent Undergraduates
First year (0-30 credits completed)	\$5,500—No more than \$3,500 in Subsidized loans	\$9,500—No more than \$3,500 in Subsidized loans
Second year (31-60 credits completed)	\$6,500—No more than \$4,500 in Subsidized loans.	\$10,500—No more than \$4,500 in Subsidized loans
Third Year + (completed 61 or more credits)	\$7,500—No more than \$5,500 in Subsidized loans	\$12,500—No more than \$5,500 in Subsidized loans
Aggregate Loan Limits	No more than \$31,000 combined sub/unsub	No more than \$57,500 combined sub/unsub

# **Financing Options**

#### Additional Financial Assistance

#### Federal Direct PLUS/Private Loan Eligibility

Through a separate application process, additional loans may be available to students and their families:

- Parents of Dependent Students can apply for a Direct Parent Loan (PLUS) at StudentLoans.gov
- Graduate and Law Students can apply for a Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate/Professional Students (GradPLUS) at StudentLoans.gov
- All Students and Parents of Dependent Students can apply for private loans through <u>FASTChoice</u> Visit our Loan Program <u>website</u> for full details.

• Plus and Private loans are disbursed directly to UA. Any overage creates a credit balance which will be refunded by the Office of Student Accounts (can be used for books, expenses, etc.).



## Loan Lender vs. Servicer

#### Your loan servicer:

- Manages the repayment of your debt/collects repayments
- Tracks due dates and minimums
- Ensures you don't slip into delinquency or default


If you need to change your repayment plan, work out a new payment schedule, ask for deferral or forbearance, or verify any loan forgiveness you may qualify for, contact your loan servicer.

It's your servicer's job to keep you in good standing by giving you the support and resources you need.
