Community and Corporate ESL Program

This program meets the diverse needs of community members who use English as a second language. Services include:

Full-time participants spend 18 hours each week in daytime courses that address four areas of English proficiency: reading efficiently, writing clearly, communicating in spoken English, and using grammar correctly. Students develop the language and study skills that can ensure success in their university coursework.
