

# The University of Akron Main and Wayne Campuses Enrollment Summary Fall Semester 2017

## Fall 2017

Total enrollment for Fall 2017 is 22,104 -- a decrease of 4.5% over the previous fall semester

## **Highlights**

#### Enrollment

- New freshmen enrollment increased 8.1% (n +280) compared to fall semester 2016
- Undergraduate enrollment (by direct admission) in The College of Engineering increased 5.2% (n +119) since fall semester 2016
- Professional enrollment in The School of Law increased 5.7% (n +25) over the previous fall semester
- Enrollment in The Williams Honors College increased 11.4% (n +228) over the previous fall semester

#### Demographics

- Professional out of state enrollment in The School of Law is up 9.9% compared to Fall 2016
- Graduate/Professional students under the age of 25 increased 14.9% over previous fall semester
- Undergraduate out of state enrollment increased 6.8% over previous fall semester






### Comparison Enrollment By College of Major By Level--Fall Semesters
