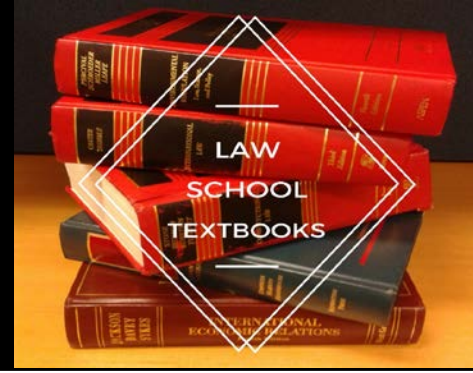
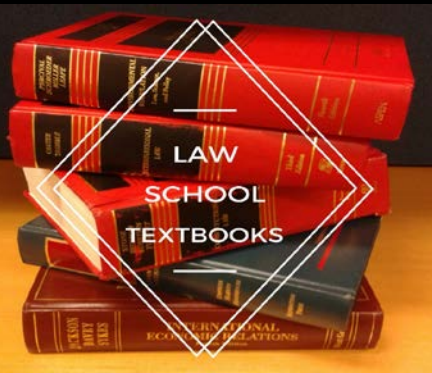

# SEOUL ARRIVAL

## Incheon Airport

- About 60-90 minutes outside of Seoul

- \* Limousine Bus (about 14,000 won - \$12.35)
- \* Korail Airport Express (about 14,800 won) and then subway transfer (about 3,000 won)
- \* International taxi (about 65,000 won)

- Wifi hotspot / cell phone rental

# SEOUL ARRIVAL – “DWELL STUDENT” OPTION

## Arrive in Seoul on July 13<sup>th</sup> / 14<sup>th</sup> (Saturday or Sunday)

- Adjacent to train station and closer to Kyung Hee
- Double bed or twin room
  - \* 10-15 minute walk from site of Seoul classes
  - \* About \$52 per night
  - \* Simple breakfast for \$4.50 per day





# SEOUL ARRIVAL – “BLESSING IN” OPTION

## Arrive in Seoul on July 13<sup>th</sup> or 14<sup>th</sup> (Saturday or Sunday)

- Block of rooms at Blessing in Seoul Residence

# (ALT.) TOKYO ARRIVAL

## Narita Airport v. Haneda Airport

- Fewer flights into Haneda, but closer
- Narita about 60-90 minutes outside of Tokyo; Haneda about 15 minutes
- \* Limousine Bus (about 3,000 yen)
- \* JR Narita Express (about 3,000 yen)
- \* Keisei line train (about 2,000 yen)

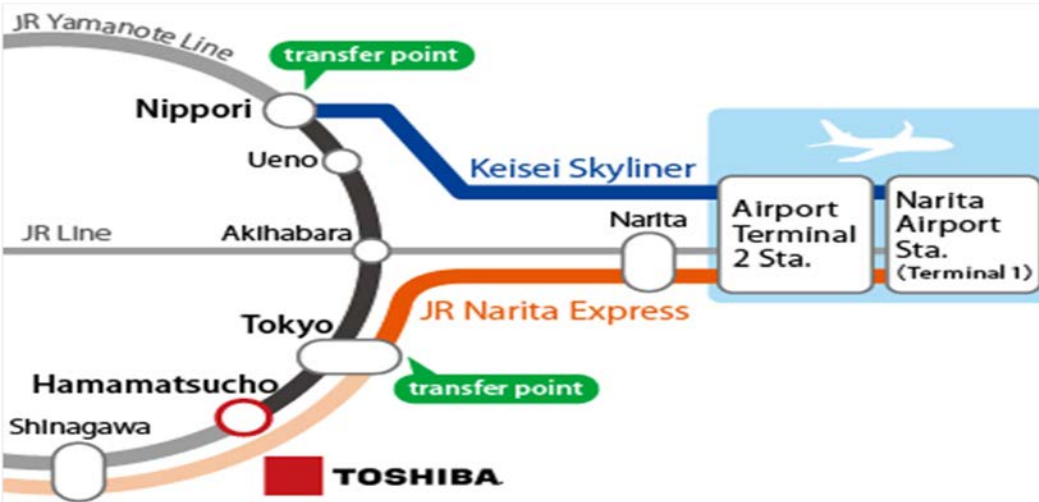
