Continued Growth Since 2008

- Anticipated Over 700+ Scholars (Fall 2019 All Programs)
- COF Retention Rate 92%
- CS Pilot– Retention Rate 69%
 - Declined Services 50%
- Graduation/GPAs
 - Over 1,000 Graduates
 - Graduation Rate 72%
 - Average GPA 3.2
 - Average ACT 24
