

COVID-19: Back to Campus (Fall 2020)

A CITI Program complimentary course to train faculty, staff, and students on COVID-19 safety for their return to campus.

Deadline to complete: September 30, 2020

This complimentary course, presented in three modules, provides an overview of COVID-19, prevention strategies, recommended laboratory practices, and points to consider as students, faculty, and staff move forward to a return to activities and operations within research institution and medical school settings. The approximate time to complete the main course is approximately 1.5 hours. Supplemental modules focused on topics related to research with human subjects, animal care and use, and working with patients who may be infected or suspected with COVID-19 provide learners the option to review these topics if applicable to their current work or school setting.
