As part of UA's Bachelor of Arts requirements, students must demonstrate foreign language competency through the intermediate level

It is recommended for students to use their elective hours at Stark State to explore pursuing a double major or minor using TAG approved courses. Students should work with a UA advisor to identify a double major or minor.
